

ANNUAL DAY - 'SEEDS OF HOPE'

Experiential learning @ Embassy Academy

December witnessed enriching experiential learning across the school, with hands-on and reflective activities fostering gratitude, creativity, inquiry, and real-world understanding beyond textbooks.

Across Pre-Primary classes, learning came alive through story narration competitions, music periods, Montessori lab experiences including pouring tasks, and exploration of hard and soft objects. Festive Christmas-themed elf activities added joy, while thumbprint thank-you card making nurtured gratitude towards support staff, drivers, administrative staff, teachers, and the Principal.

Primary students strengthened conceptual understanding through hands-on history activities using coins, science learning through paper fan making, and language development via word building, sentence formation, and creative expression.

In the upper grades, learning expanded through role play on humour in the amphitheatre, experiential activities on emotional balance inspired by Equilibrium in Life, interview-based learning on Food and Health, and STEM projects converting a solar fan into a solar windmill.

Together, these experiences enhanced communication, collaboration, critical thinking, and problem-solving skills.
