The competition proved that with a little creativity, even the simplest materials can be given a new life while encouraging environmentally responsible choices.



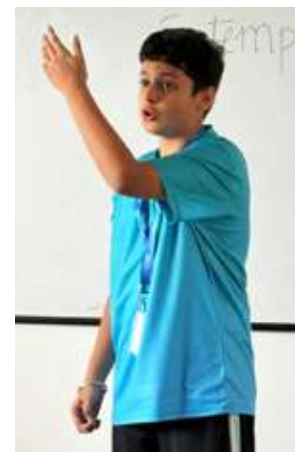
Competitions That Fostered Creativity

Centred on the thought-provoking theme, **“The Impact of World Population Growth on the Economy, Education and Natural Resources,”** students of Grades **VI to IX** will be encouraged to think critically, express themselves confidently and engage in meaningful conversations. It's time to prepare, participate and let every idea find its voice.



Experiential Learning

June turned classrooms into spaces of exploration, where ideas were touched, tested and experienced. From Grade 1 little learners stepping into the world of animals through Hindi role play, creating paper dogs and discovering numbers with an abacus, to young innovators designing shapes with Bee-Bots in the STEM Lab, every activity brought learning to life.

Science came alive as students explored mixtures and solutions, measured volume using the displacement method, observed bacteria, protozoa and earthworm specimens under a microscope, and uncovered the science of lemon pickling. They also modelled the Earth with latitudes and longitudes, explored chemical reactions with antacids, learnt about safety, first aid, composting and responsible E-Waste disposal.

Through the Green Pledge Board, My Dream Earth posters, Dumb Charades, and shape-based learning, learners discovered that the best lessons are those experienced beyond the pages of a textbook.
